Renovations planned for Kentwood Activities Center

The Kentwood Activities Center at 355 48th St. SE will be closed for renovations from December 7, 2017-March 2, 2018. During this time, staff will be relocated to Kentwood City Hall (4900 Breton SE) and scheduled programs will move to alternate locations.

The Activities Center is one of the City of Kentwood's oldest facilities and this renovation is its largest in over 30 years. Renovations include a new HVAC system, updated and expanded restrooms, a new sound system for the gym, and a certified commercial teaching kitchen. The teaching kitchen will provide expanded educational opportunities for the community. It is also available for caterers and other food business entrepreneurs.

Funding for the renovations are made possible through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. CDBG is a federal grant program utilizing funds received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
