Park Information:

This property was acquired and is used for wetland mitigation purposes and as a water filtration process site. Pathways were developed allowing for controlled community access around the wetlands. The pathways, decking for fishing and picnic shelter were developed with the assistance of a Natural Resources Trust fund Grant and the City's dedicated Park Millage. The restroom building was added later.

The park serves as Kentwood's south end trail head for the Paul Henry Trail which starts at 60th and East Paris and hooks up to and uses the East Paris Park Trail along 60th. Trail hooks up to the M6 Trail (1 mile west).
