

Home Occupation Business

The city of Kentwood encourages its residents to pursue greater independence and financial resources through the creation of home based businesses. Such occupations provide a wide range of opportunities for the citizens of Kentwood and serve as incubators for new businesses. Home occupations help enhance economic development in our region.

However, care must be taken to ensure that such businesses do not substantially detract from the quality of life of our neighborhood and the safety and welfare of our citizens. To accomplish these goals the city of Kentwood, through the Zoning Ordinance, has established standards of operation to limit the scale and impact of such businesses.

In order to gain City authorization of a home occupation business, the resident must first complete a *Home Occupation Business Application*. The application identifies the Kentwood ordinance standards. In addition to the application, an inspection of the home's business area is required to ensure the ordinance standards are met. The applicant must contact the Kentwood Planning Department (554-0810) to schedule and inspection. A working smoke detector must be in close proximity to the business area and a functional fire extinguisher must be on the premises to meet Fire Department standards. A one time application/inspection fee of \$25.00 is required at the time of application. As long as the business operates within the standards of the Kentwood Zoning Ordinance it is entitled to be conducted from the residence. It is not necessary to annually renew the authorization of the business.
