The City of Kentwood will be sponsoring a community wide cleanup called Pride Day on May 7th to help keep our community clean. The drop-off location is at the Kentwood Recycling Center (5068 Breton Avenue) and is limited to Kentwood residents with proof by picture identification.

The event is strictly limited to the hours of 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. as dumpsters will be delivered and taken away at those times. Please respect these restrictions so we can continue to provide this positive community service. **YARD WASTE AND TIRES NOT ACCEPTED.** The **Kent County Department of Public Works** will be on hand to accept household hazardous waste items. They will not be accepting latex paint. Further information may be obtained by calling 632-7920.

The Salvation Army will be on hand to accept gently used items for donations. **Comprenew** will also be present to receive electronic waste (mobile telephones, computers, fax machines, and other items will be accepted at no charge). CRT screens will not be accepted but can be dropped off directly at any Comprenew commercial location.

Residents are asked to enter the drive off Breton Avenue where volunteers will be checking for residence and approved items for disposal.
